High School *Co-op*

Our co-op opportunity is a paid program designed to prepare **high school seniors** to enter and succeed in a Registered Apprenticeship program. Ahaus co-ops are a starting point toward a successful career path with opportunities for advancement.

Our Co-op program entails:

- Training and curriculum based on industry standards, approved by Ahaus management and the Department of Labor.
- Hands-on experience that simulates the work performed in the apprenticeship, while observing proper supervision and safety protocols.
- Education and pre-vocational services that prepare participants to meet the minimum qualifications for entry into a Registered Apprenticeship program.

HS (Summer) or Post-High School *Internship*

An internship is a temporary job role that is often related to one's academic field of study or career interests. It offers practical experience within a professional setting by giving insight into company culture and daily operations, assisting with specific competencies needed to complete a degree, and providing an income along the way.

Some of the benefits of internship include:

- **Gain experience:** Job listings often state that they prefer candidates with educational and job experience. If you're new to the workforce or attending school, you may consider looking for an internship to gain the experience required for most entry-level positions.
- **Identify career goals:** An internship can give you an authentic experience in a job role by providing you with an introductory experience to a career path, its duties and daily operations. If you enjoy your internship, this might indicate that your career is on the right path.



Post-High School *Apprenticeship*

Registered Apprenticeship is an employer-driven training model for aspiring tradespeople. Apprenticeship programs provide on-the-job learning from an experienced mentor and related classroom instruction on the technical and academic aspects of the job. The training is rooted in industry skill standards and competencies.

Registered Apprenticeship is the term used for apprenticeship programs that have a formal structure, in which employers have established learning standards that meet national and state quality expectations.

When individuals successfully complete a Registered Apprenticeship program, they receive a national credential from the U.S. Department of Labor that is recognized anywhere in the industry.

At Ahaus, Apprentices earn a paycheck and receive full-time status as soon as they begin an apprenticeship, so they are earning while they build their skills and knowledge. Apprentices also earn progressively higher wages as their skills develop.
